Animal Hoarding

» More than the typical number of companion animals. Inability to provide even minimal standards of nutrition, sanitation, shelter and veterinary care, with this neglect often resulting in starvation, illness and death.



- » City of Casey Located South East of Melbourne CBD
- » Population 290,000
- » Growth Rate 140 per week approx
- » Approx 400sq Km
- » Projected Population of 459,000 by 2036



Investigative Process

- Establishing ID of offender
- Establishment of relevant offences
- Background checking, prior offence history
- Evidence and Intelligence gathering
- Development of operational order/briefing
- Obtaining Search Warrant
- Execution of Search Warrant



Casey

- » 14 cats (none registered or chipped)
- » 15 dogs (none registered, some chipped)
- » 10 rabbits
- » 10 guinea pigs
- » 6 ponies (dead pony found in barn)
- » 5 sheep
- » 9 goats, 2 pigs
- » 1 alpaca
- » 300-400 poultry (chooks, ducks, geese etc)





Who was involved in the Search?

- > 7 x Animal Management Officers
- > 1 x Environmental Health Officer
- > 1 x Town Planning Enforcement Officer
- > 2 x RSPCA Inspectors
- > 2 x Police Officers
- > 1 x Veterinarian



What was found upon execution of search warrant?

- » Many dead, diseased and injured animals
- » Major infestation of vermin (rats, mice)
- » Many animals suffering serious malnutrition and dehydration
- » Added bonus of Cannabis crop (hydroponic set up)







- » What was seized, removed, impounded?
 - » All dogs and cats were seized.
 - » Poultry Dozens required immediate destruction due to advanced state of serious disease
 - » Several ponies, sheep and goats required immediate vet treatment with ongoing treatment also required (1 goat destroyed)
 - » Hydroponic Set Up (By Police)





- » Unfortunately we were unable to remove all animals
- » Follow up visit undertaken 1 week later found the property to be vacant with all animals removed
- » All attempts to locate proved fruitless



- » There is a god Call received from rural Council seeking information about Council Mobile Rubbish Bin – approx 1 month after search
- » Serial number matched up with address of our animal hoarder ©
- » GOT HER!!!!!!



List of Charges

- » 19 POCTA Offences (Including Aggravated Cruelty)
- » 29 Domestic Animals Act
- » 6 City of Casey Community Local Law

» Total 54 charges



Prosecution Outcome

- Matter Proven
- Offender Convicted
- Animal Banning Order put in place (2.5 years) effective immediately
- > Fine \$5000
- Offender had several previous animal cruelty convictions and 1 banning order
